2.1	PC Bond delivered the report covering 15 March to 14 April. There were no reports of crimes of violence, drunk and Disorderly house breaking, theft, or public nuisance. One 21 year old male was detained regarding cannabis misuse.		
2.2	Crime Prevention. This is the time of year where there is increased risk of theft of power tools etc. from sheds and outbuildings. Also, beware of online scams and requests for payments. Ensure the line is broken by phoning a friend/relative before returning a call requesting payment to ensure a bone fide payment request. ERC area is experiencing a scam relating to duped purchasing of I tune vouchers.		
2.3	There have been several checks on speeding through the village especially when the A736 was closed. 2 drivers were stopped and warned but no-one was caught speeding to excess. Speeding will be kept under review. A resident enquired re the obvious visibility of the police when conducting speed checks thus warning drivers of their presence. It is a requirement that police must remain
