3.2	A736 Reduced Speed Limit Our request for a reduction in the speed limit on the A736 at Caldwell Golf Club to around the bend at Welsh's Garages has not been accepted by Roads Department. UCC will request a meeting with Roads to discuss this matter further.	GS

5.1	ERC Disability Action ERC Disability Action will visit UCC in August 2017.		
5.2	Data Protection Neilston Community Council has some concerns about data protection issues but UCC is satisfied regarding this matter.

5.6	20mph Default Speed Limit Consultation Communication was received from Mark Ruskell MSP regarding his consultation for making the default speed limit for built-up areas 20mph, replacing the current 30mph limit. An open call was held with Mark Russell MSP to discuss his upcoming parliamentary bill proposing that all existing 30 mph limits become 20mph speed limits by default.
